In preparation for Synod 2023, the Pope is seeking worldwide consultation with Bishops, Clergy, Religious and Laity. His hope and prayer is that everyone will participate - rich, poor, marginalised and individuals and groups traditionally excluded by society and sometime by the Church.

On Wednesday, 27 October, priests in the Archdiocese of Durban gathered with Archbishop Mandla Jwara, to listen to one another, share their thoughts around the direction the Church is taking and formulate questions for the Vatican Synod in 2023. This was the first time in almost two years that the Clergy have been able to gather and connect with one another; the hall was alive with chatter, laughter, and serious conversation.

During Advent, the faithful of the Archdiocese will be encouraged to participate in the consultation process. Everyone will be asked to share their thoughts, experiences, and concerns regarding the Church. Questions will be circulated, and time given for young, middle aged and elderly to respond to them. Thereafter the PPC of each parish will collate a report for submission to their Deanery Council, which will then submit a report to the Diocesan Pastoral Council. The DPC will also collate reports from the different sodalities and lay groups as well as reports from the homeless and people of other faiths. The Synod Team will then finalise a report for the Archbishop to submit to the SACBC in April 2022.

We ask that you pray daily the Synod prayer which calls on the Holy Spirit to assist and guide us as we navigate a completely altered world. This can be found on all social media platforms.

RENEWAL OF MANDATES

A reminder to parish priests that the term of office for all Ministers of Holy Communion ends the week after the Feast of Christ the King each year.

All parish priests have the Faculty to appoint and renew the mandates of Ministers of Holy Communion. It is recommended that this appointment be for one year, renewable for five consecutive terms only. These mandates should be given in writing.

Mandates for **Extraordinary Ministers to conduct Communion Services** must be applied for to the Vicar General.
